BEING SAFE IN SCHOOL

FACE MASKS

PPE & HYGIENE: STUDENT FACE MASKS



- It is a **regulation** to wear a face covering.
- **NO** student will be allowed into school without a face mask.
- Medical exemption will allow face guard / visor.
- Students to wear face masks at all times.*
- *Students will remove the face mask correctly if necessary to remove mask for a short period (eg. Water).

PPE & HYGIENE: STUDENT FACE MASKS

- **NO** student will be allowed into school without a face mask.
- Mask must be plain / lightly patterned.
- No inappropriate logos / symbols.
- **NO** bandanas or snood type masks allowed.



PPE & HYGIENE: STUDENT FACE MASKS



- **NO** student will be allowed into school without a face mask.
- Mask to be worn on corridors and when **unable to be 2 metres apart.**
- Can be removed during rest or eating breaks.
- Can be removed outside if **2 metres apart.**
- **WASH hands regularly.**

PPE & HYGIENE:TEACHER MASK



- It is a **regulation** for teachers to wear a face covering also.
- Teacher to wear face mask if less than 2 metres from student.
- Teacher has the option of wearing *only* the visor if 2 metres or more from student.
- Teacher who may wish to move in the room must wear face mask and may also use visor.

BEING SAFE IN SCHOOL

HAND & DESK CLEANING



PPE & HYGIENE:TEACHER MASK



- It is a **regulation** for teachers to wear a face covering also.
- Teacher to wear face mask if less than 2 metres from student.
- Teacher has the option of wearing *only* the visor if 2 metres or more from student.
- Teacher who may wish to move in the room must wear face mask and may also use visor.

CLASSROOM PRACTICE: CLEANING

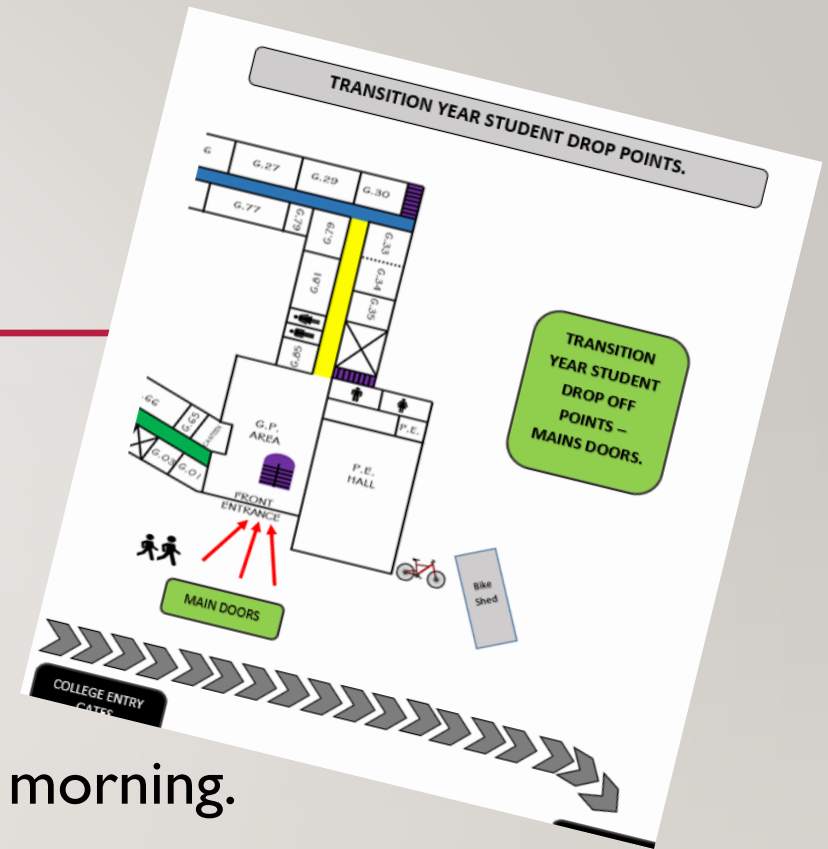
- Students hand sanitise on entering the classroom.
- Teacher sprays down desk.
- Student takes a wipe from wall mounted paper dispenser.
- Student cleans down desk and chair.
- Student disposes of wipe carefully in the Covid Bin.
- Process repeated at the end of class.
- It is essential that the Covid Bin is used for this form of cleaning **ONLY**.

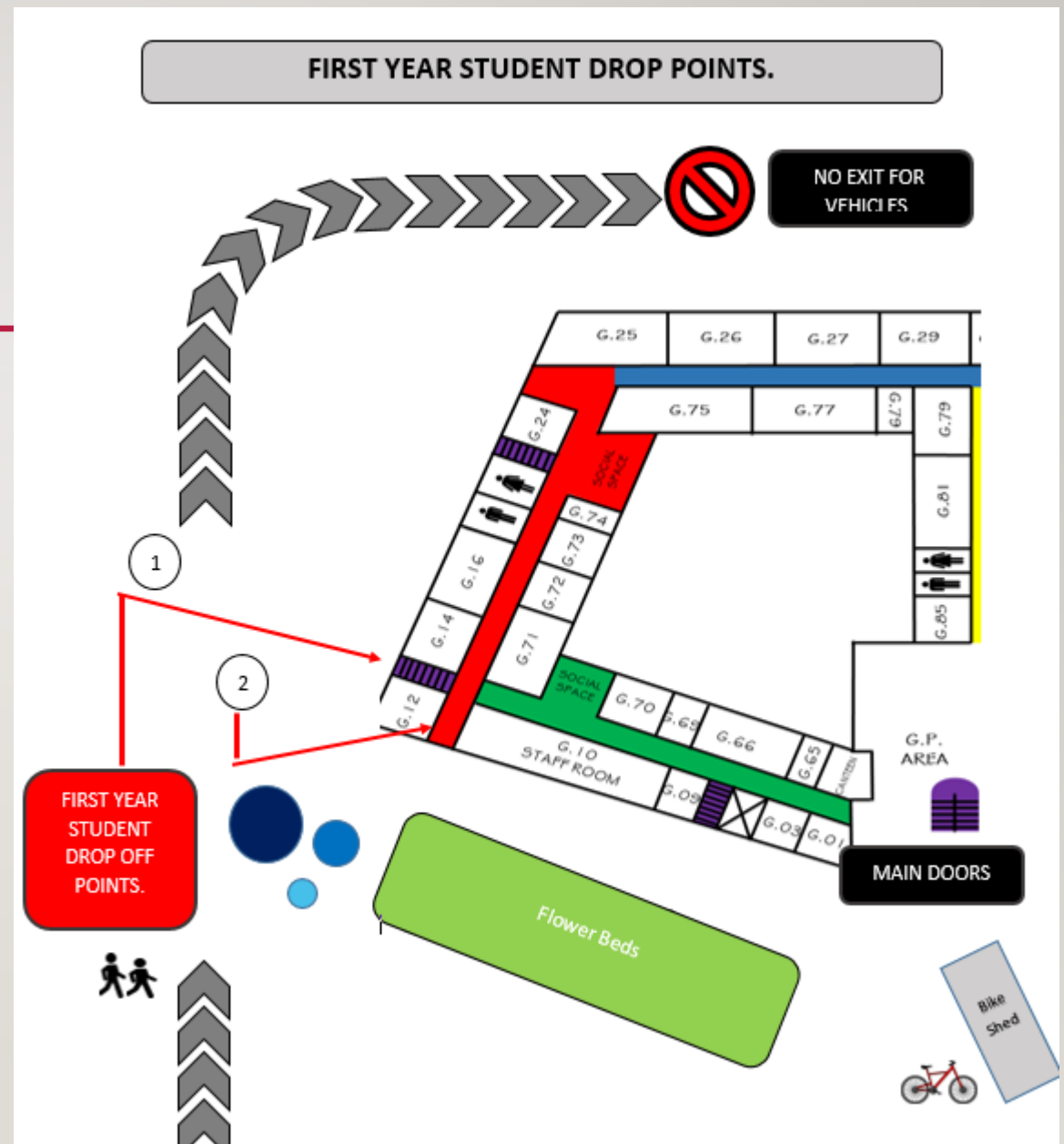
ENTRY & EXIT

- Students must go directly to their **BASE** class each morning.

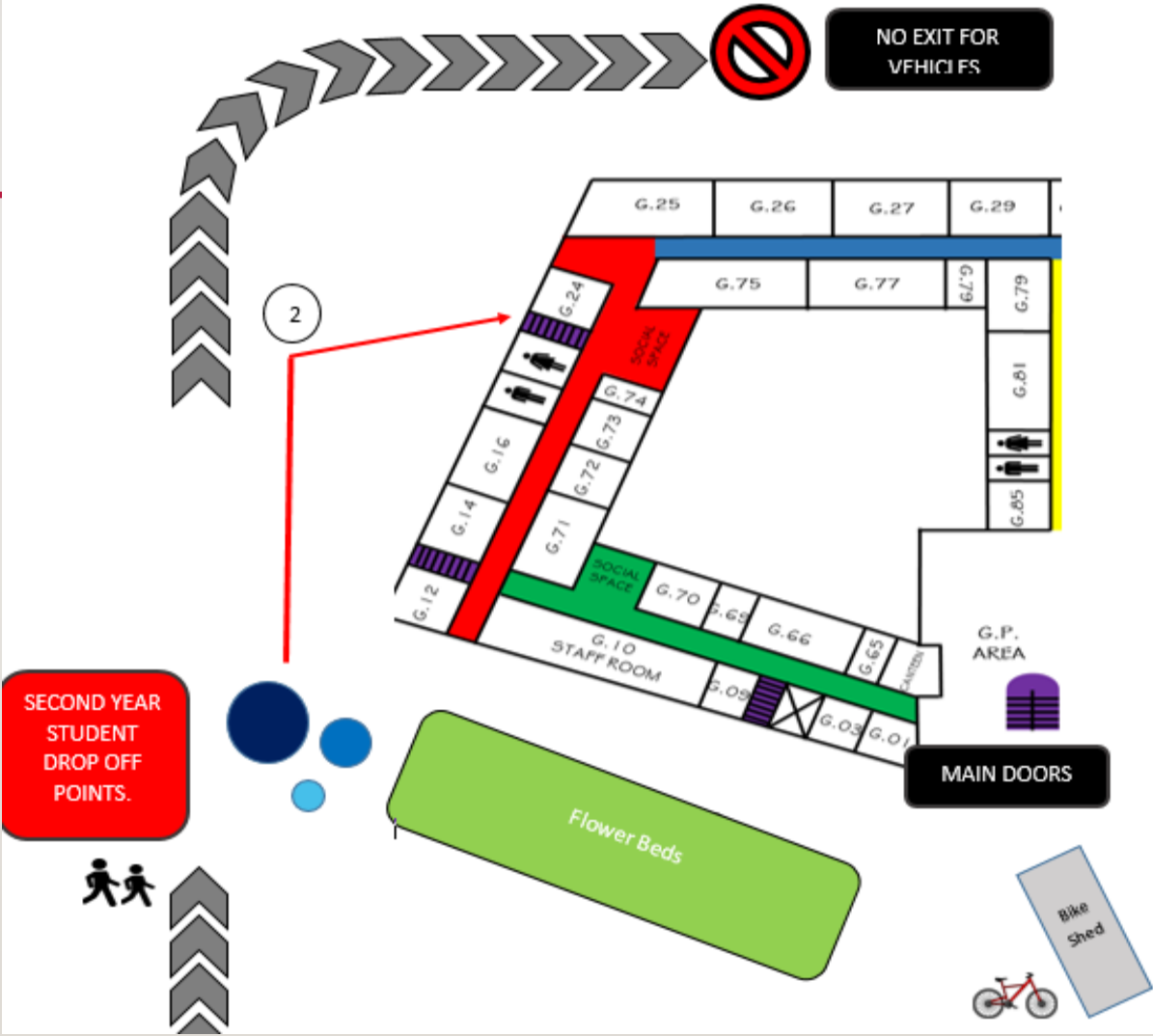


1ST YEAR



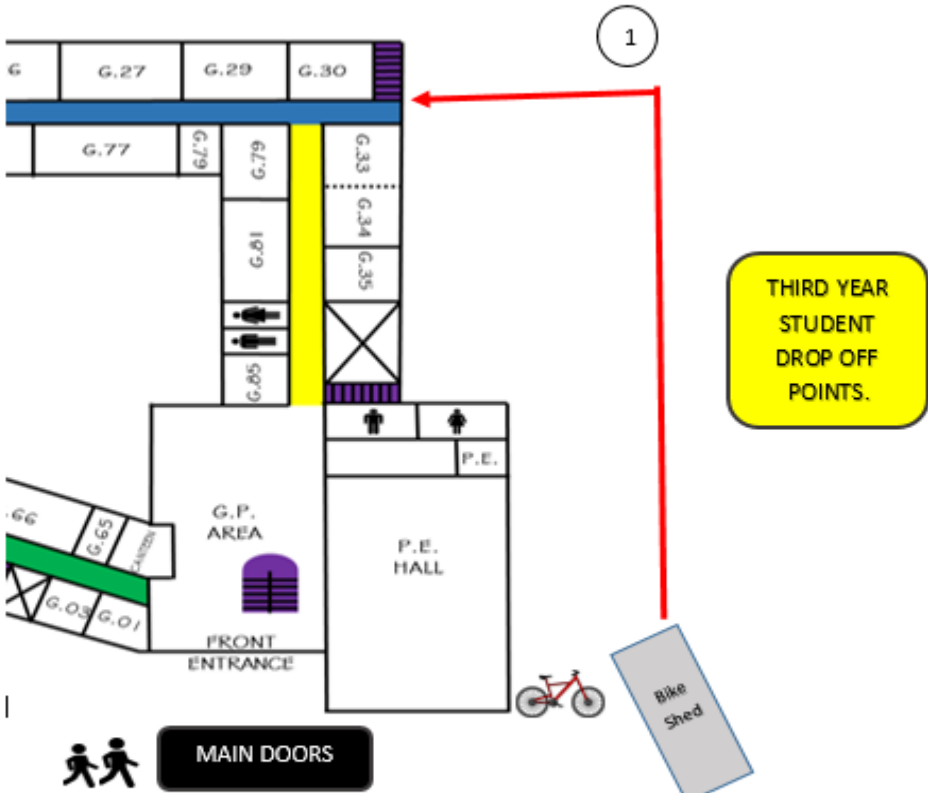
2ND YEAR

SECOND YEAR STUDENT DROP POINTS.



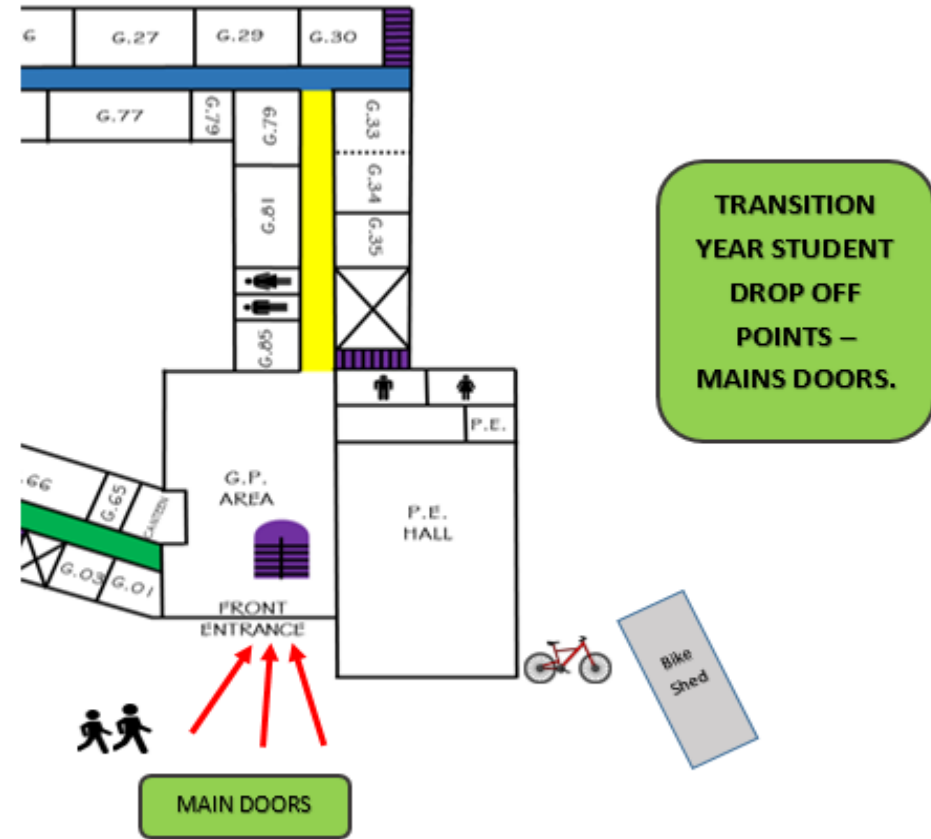
3RD YEAR

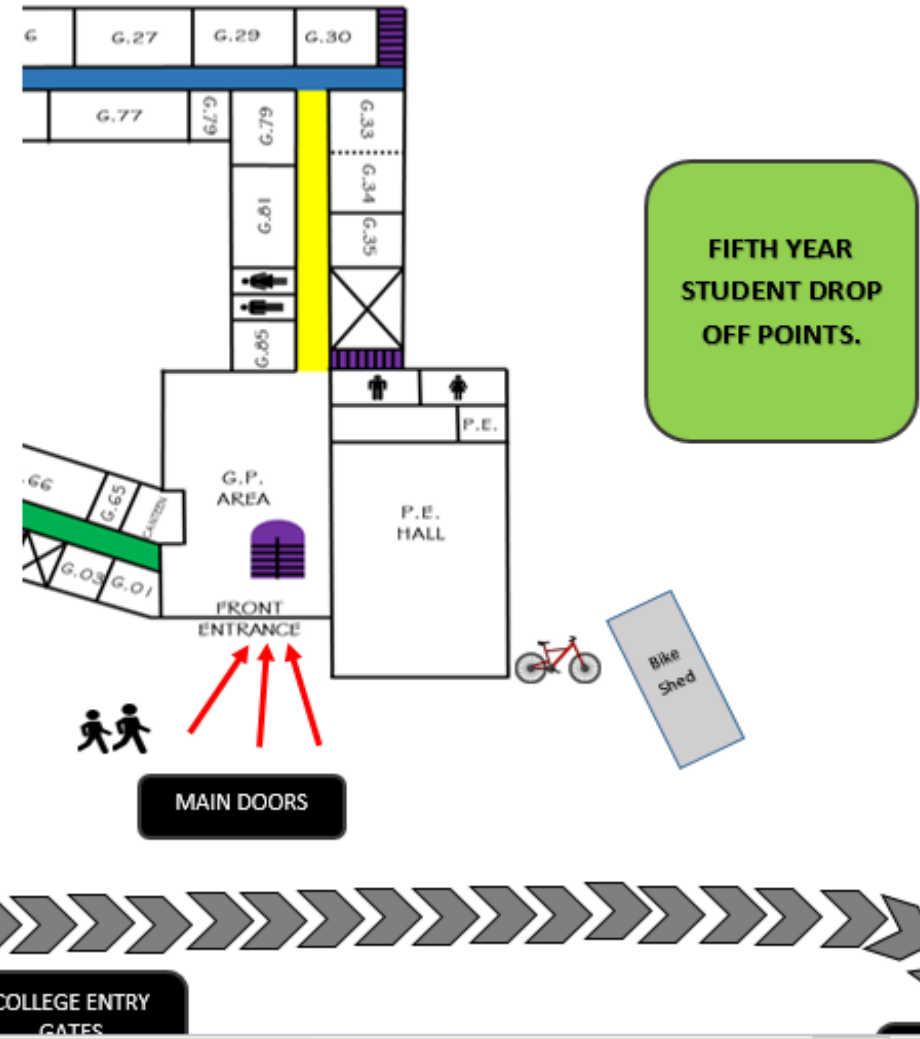
TRANSITION YEAR STUDENT DROP POINTS.

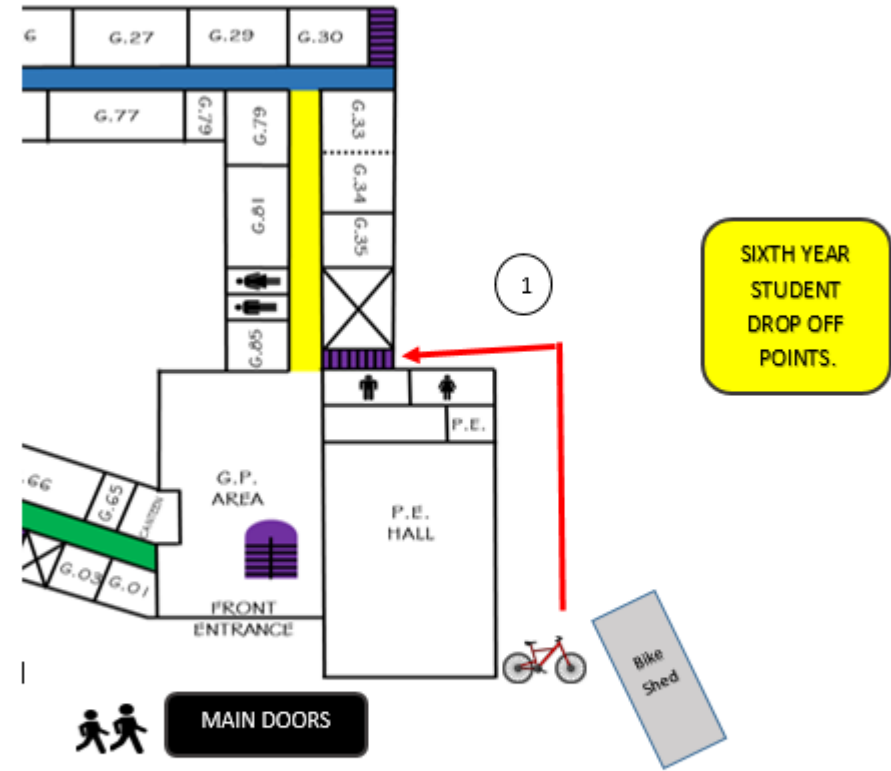

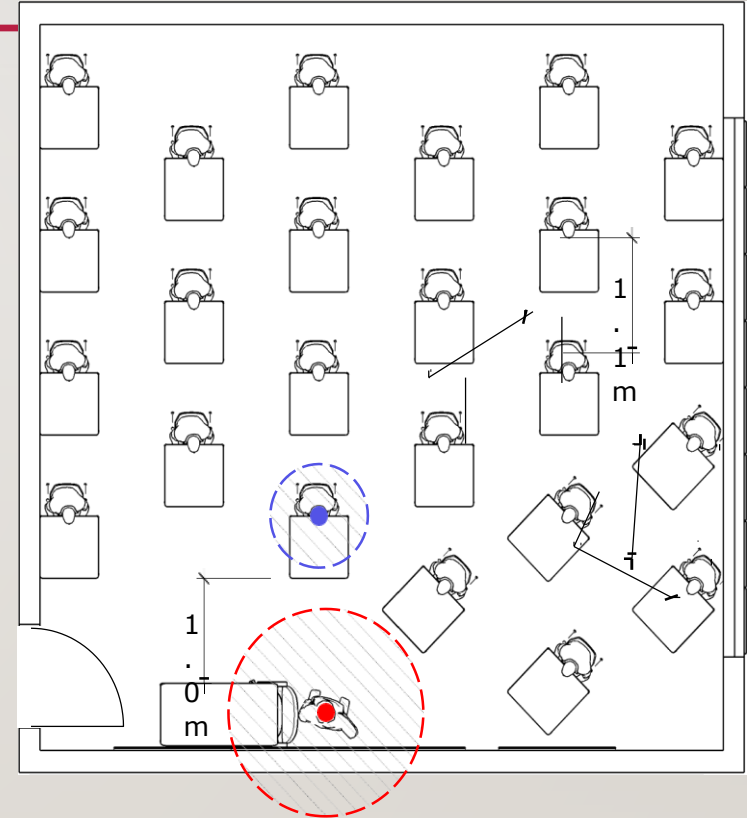

CORRIDORS.

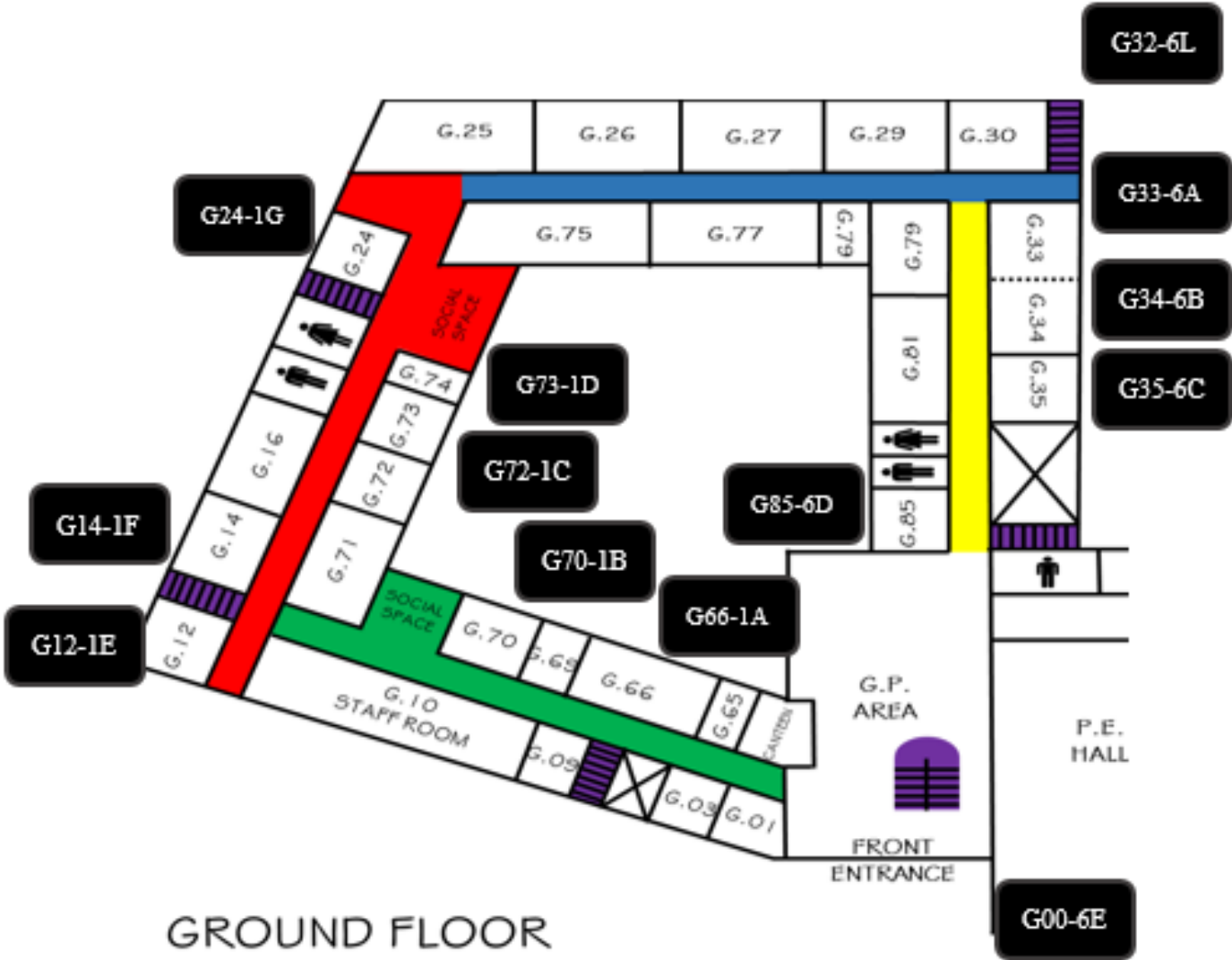
- Students may not congregate in hallways or in other classes.
- ALL corridors have a **LEFT ONLY** walking system.



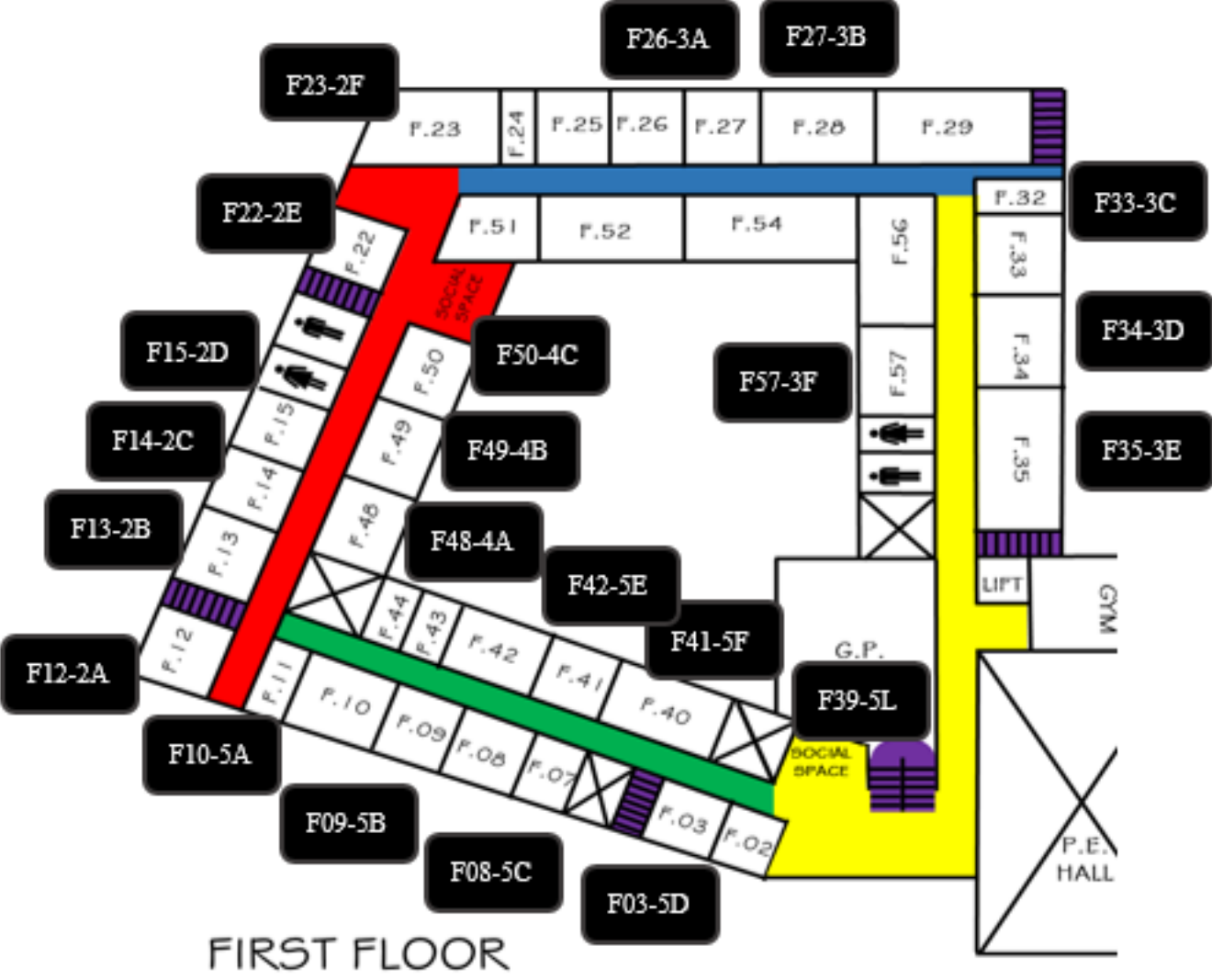

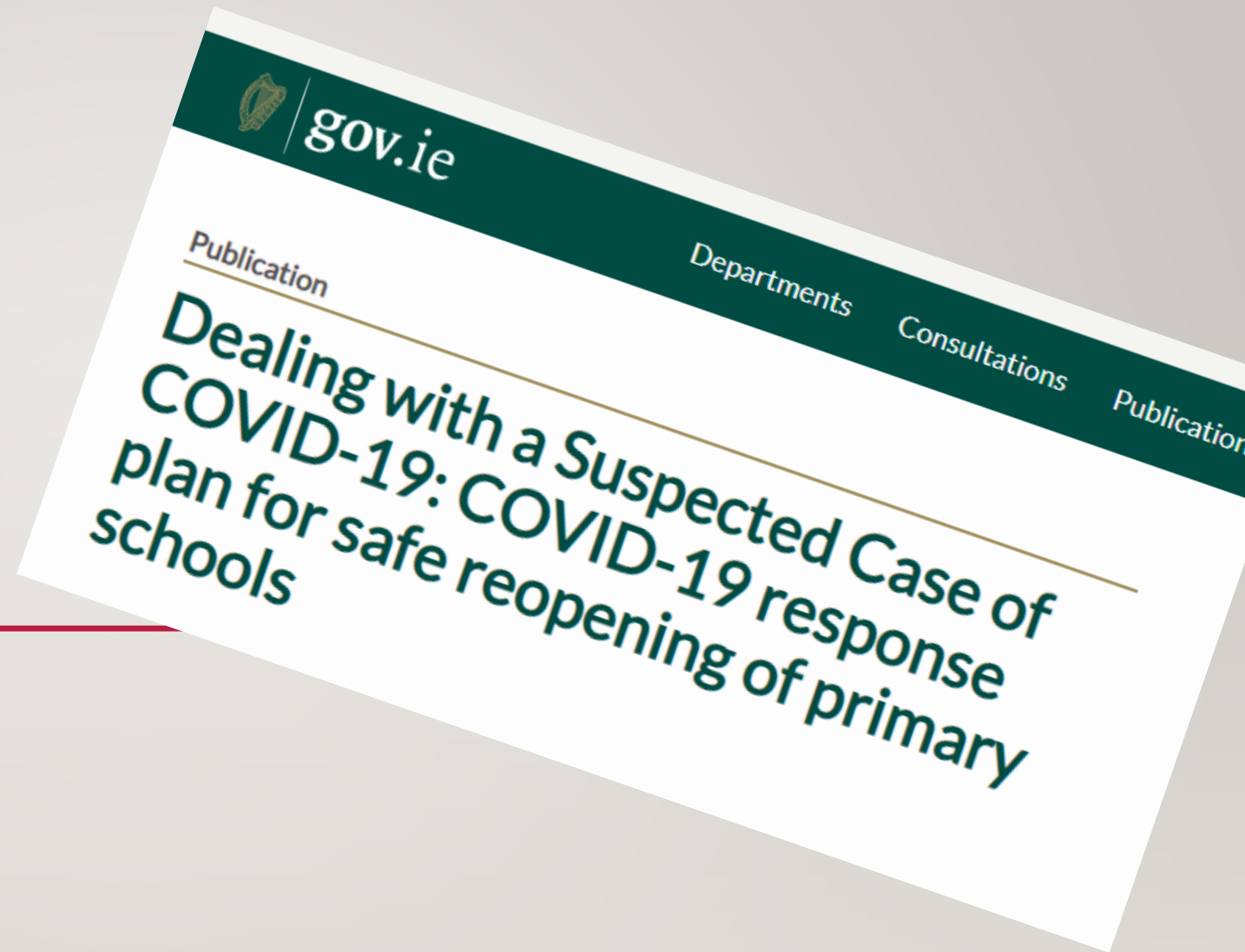


THINK AND BE SAFE

- No action that will risk the health and safety of anyone else
- Rules on face-masks: your mask and others
- No spitting
- No chewing gum
- Use of water

COVID TRAINING:

What happens if?



BASIC ADVICE

- Staff or pupils should **not** attend school if displaying any symptoms of COVID-19.
- The symptoms are:
 - a fever (high temperature - 38 degrees Celsius or above)
 - a cough - this can be any kind of cough, not just dry
 - shortness of breath or breathing difficulties
 - loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

STUDENT ARRIVES WITH NO MASK?

- It has been reiterated to parents that students cannot attend school without a face mask.
- Student is sent to office and is given a disposable mask.
- The charge is €1.
- Only after accepting mask is student allowed into school.

STUDENT ARRIVES WITH COVID SYMPTOM?

- Student is immediately taken to the Isolation Room.
- The Isolation Room is **Room G69** (Fr. Jim's old office).
- A member of SMT is contacted.
- Temperature is checked if presenting with fever as symptom.
- Parent is contacted. Student remains in supervised Isolation Room until collected.

STUDENT ARRIVES WITH COVID SYMPTOM?

- A mask is provided for the person presenting with symptoms.
- The student should avoid touching people, surfaces and objects.
- Any tissue/waste used by the student is placed in the waste bag provided.
- Arrange for appropriate cleaning of the isolation area and work areas involved.
- Advise the parent to contact GP and for child to self-isolate.

STUDENT DEVELOPS COVID SYMPTOM IN CLASS?

- Member of SMT is rung on WhatsApp (Pippa / Anita / Alan).
- SMT will collect student from room and follow procedures as in previous question.
- If no member of SMT available, remove student to corridor with chair. Send another student to office for assistance.
- Social distancing is maintained while moving student to Isolation Room.
- 2nd Isolation Room: Principal's office.

STUDENT DEVELOPS COVID SYMPTOM IN CLASS?

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- SMT will collect student from room and follow procedures as in previous question.
- If no member of SMT available, remove student to corridor with chair. Send another student to office for assistance.
